To those interested who have undergraduate studies in: Agronomy, Biology, Agroecology, Environmental Engineering, Forest Engineering, Zootechnician Agronomist, Veterinary Zootechnician, Agroindustry Engineer, Agrobiology or related degree, to participate in the admission process to conduct studies of Master of Science in Sustainable Management of Agroecosystems, promotion 2018, at its headquarters in BUAP Ecocampus Valsequillo, Puebla, Puebla, MEXICO.

The Master's program has an orientation to research and is recognized by the National Quality Postgraduate Program (PNPC), so that admitted students will have the option of financial support from the National Council of Science and Technology (CONACyT). In order to access these economic supports, students must do their research work in Mexico.

The postgraduate program has four academic areas: Agroecological management of biodiversity, Agroecological management of soil and water, Agroecological management of phytosanitary problems and Organic agriculture.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

1. Bachelor degree related to the profile of the academic area, where he develops his research work.
2. Minimum average of 8.0 in bachelor's degree, in a scale of 1 to 10, or equivalent in Mexico. Consult the equivalence based on the rating scale of your country.
3. Pass the entrance examination (basic knowledge focused on the postgraduate course. Interested: request a study guide). The exam can be presented online, from your country. The cost will be \$ 1000.00 m.n. (Mexico) or its equivalent in dollars (USD). The payment will be referenced (request information from the Postgraduate Administration, with Patricia Vela Romero: masagro@correo.buap.mx) and send the payment voucher by e-mail.
4. Check English skills equivalent to a minimum of 420 TOEFL-ITP points. For those interested who speak a language other than Spanish, they are informed that the academic sessions in the master's program are taught in Spanish, thus they requires auditory comprehension, oral production and written production, whose level of proficiency can be demonstrated through the SIELE exam (International Service of Evaluation of the Spanish Language), promoted by the Cervantes Institute (IC), the National Autonomous University of Mexico (UNAM), the University of Salamanca (USAL) and the University of Buenos Aires (UBA)
5. Approve the interview of the Admission Council. It will cover by videoconference, according to the date and time assigned by the Interview Commission and will be notified by email.
6. Be recommended by two academics and / or professionals in the agroecological area (according to point 11 of the documents to be delivered).
7. Demonstrate legal permanence in the country. The student must get their Form FM-4, of legal residence in Mexico for 2 years.
8. Cover the registration fee for the first semester. Each semester \$ 4,000.00 (Mexican pesos) or its equivalent in dollars (USD). Payment is made at the beginning of academic activities.

Will be made to the deposit referenced (request information from the Postgraduate Administration, with Patricia Vela Romero) and send the original payment receipt to the Postgraduate Coordination.

DOCUMENTS TO BE DELIVERED (ORIGINAL AND COPY).

1. Bachelor degree or constancy that it is in process or professional examination certificate or equivalent document for another type of degree. The degree or equivalent studies must be authenticated by the consulate of Mexico in the country of origin (Apostille of The Hague).
2. Certificate of studies. Authenticated.
3. Official letter indicating the average of the grades obtained in the degree, on a scale of 1 to 10, or equivalent in your country. This document is omitted if the study certificate has an average.
5. Proof of English proficiency, equivalent to a minimum of 420 points on the ITP TOEFL. For those who do not speak Spanish, present a proof of the SIELE (International Spanish Language Assessment Service) test.
6. Curriculum vitae updated.
7. Letter explaining the reasons (addressed to the program coordinator).
8. Birth certificate or proof of nationality.
9. Copy of the passport and FM-4 format.
10. Proof of address, once established in Mexico.
11. Two photographs of child size (black and white).
12. Name, profession and data (Institution and email address) of three recognized researchers, who can give a recommendation of the applicant.

APPLICATIONS FOR ASPIRERS THAT DELIVER COMPLETE DOCUMENTATION ON THE ESTABLISHED DATES WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTED.

ADMISSION PROCESS

Propaedeutic Course

The Propaedeutic Course is optional, it is a face-to-face course at the postgraduate program headquarters and takes place from February 16 to May 12, 2018. The cost is \$ 1000.00, presenting a payment card before the 14th. February 2018 in the Postgraduate Coordination, which grants the right to take the admission exam at no additional cost. Payment is made referenced (reports with Patricia Vela Romero).

Admission Test

Pass the admission exam, which will take place from May 28 to 30, 2018. it can do online from the postgraduate headquarters, at the time agreed with the candidates, at a cost of \$ 1000.00 m.n. or its equivalent in US dollars (USD). Send the payment form by email to masagro@correo.buap.mx, before May 18, 2018 (This payment is only if you did not cover the cost of the Propaedeutic Course). Payment will be referenced.

Delivery of documents for the admission process

Send by email to masagro@correo.buap.mx, in pdf format, apostilled documents (professional title, certificate of qualifications, birth certificate and passport) for the admission process, as well as the other documents that will be delivered, from May 30 to June 8.

Interviews

From June 25 to 27, from 9:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., at the Postgraduate Coordination. The interview will be made only to applicants who meet the admission requirements, according to the list that will be published on June 29, 2018, where the date and time will be indicated for each application. The interview is face-to-face, and only applicants located more than 500 km from the city of Puebla, Mexico, may opt by video-conference on the date and time indicated.

Publication of accepted list

On Friday, June 29, 2018, the result of the admission process will be sent via email. The students that are accepted will deliver their documents, in original and copy, from August 1 to 6, 2018, at the postgraduate offices in Puebla, Mexico.

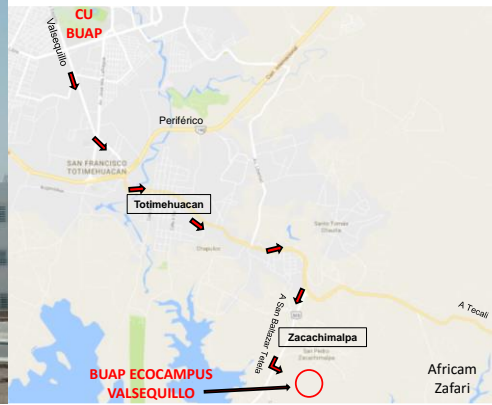
